ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicant must currently work for an agency that provides Weatherization Assistance Program services as an agency employee or a subcontractor.

Applicant must have been an employee in the agency providing WAP services for at least one year.

TO APPLY:

Applicant or a person nominating someone must indicate on the application whether the nomination is for the technical or administrative award and then submit a short essay (500 words or less) on the application form detailing how the applicant or nominee exemplifies the characteristics personified by John Langford.

Applicant must fill out and submit the application by April 22, 2024.

John Langford began his long career in weatherization as the Weatherization Coordinator for Central Virginia AAA in 1978. In 1980, he and his wife Joanne formed their own company, J&J Weatherization, which is still weatherizing homes today. During his career John became an expert in all aspects of weatherization including building science, insulation, energy auditing, HVAC work, chimney re-lining, training, mobile home weatherization, and much more. Prior to his retirement in 2013 John served as a lead trainer for DOE's Hot Climate Initiative, a lead trainer for the Association of Energy Conservation Professionals (AECOP), and a contract trainer for CHP Energy Solutions Research & Training.

John was an expert in diagnosing problems and then fixing them. He will be remembered for his work ethic, generous and kind disposition, respect for others, and ability to successfully impart his knowledge of and passion for the weatherization industry to others.
